

Lifetime Achievement Award - Tom Anderson

TOM graduated from North Branch High School in May 1969, he was not the valedictorian or the salutatorian but was involved in many activities: Football, cross country, golf, student council, homecoming candidate, basketball team manager, and acting. He was a member of a one-act play entitled "Antic Spring" by Robert Nail, playing Sam, a lover.

Growing up in a small town atmosphere influenced Tom by knowing everyone in town, having freedom to roam before the 6 o'clock whistle blew, being able to hunt and fish and learning to love nature.

Tom went on to earn a Bachelor of Science degree in Wildlife Biology from the University of Minnesota in 1974.

In 1975, Tom became Chisago County's first park director and under his guidance the Fish Lake and Checkerboard Parks were developed. At the same time he founded the Wild River Chapter of the National Audubon Society.

Starting in 1977, Tom became the Interpretive Naturalist and later the Director of the Lee & Rose Warner Nature Center near Marine on the St Croix. The Lee and Rose Warner Nature Center is the crown jewel of the Science Museum of Minnesota. For the next 30 years, under Tom's leadership, the Nature Center grew both in terms of acres and infrastructure.

For over 40 years, Tom has passed on his love of nature and our environment by teaching and writing. Tom has written many articles for local and national magazines and newspapers, receiving many awards in the process. Tom has authored and published 4 books during his lifetime. His first, published in 1989 is entitled "Learning Nature by a Country Road", describes his outdoor journey growing up in North Branch. (241 pages) Other books are "Black Bears- Seasons in the Wild", "Things that Bite", several region editions and "Foraging in North America". Tom has also authored and published a Tri-fold guide entitled "Northern Lights – A Guide to Natures Spectacular Light Show". All of Tom's publications are available for purchase.

In 2006, Tom helped orchestrate the sale of a portion of his family's farm to Isanti County, to develop the Irving & John Anderson County Park. Today the Park has undergone an intensive transformation to be restored from a farm into a thriving ecosystem. The Park has many trails, picnic shelters, restrooms, all aimed at providing the public the opportunity to view nature surrounded by prairie, meadows, woodland and lake views of Horseshoe and Horseleg Lakes. For those not familiar with the park, it is located south west of North Branch, on Chisago County Road 17 and Isanti County Road 18 about 2 miles west of I-35.

While retired, Tom remains active. The past year has seen Tom promoting his love of nature and the outdoors by working on developing North Branch into the "Monarch Capital of Minnesota".

Tom and his wife, Nancy live in the house that his grandfather built with native Minnesota white pine. Because of his love for the outdoors and nature they now spend their summers in the Canadian wilderness of the Yukon Territory.

When asked of his proudest achievement Tom answered, "raising his two daughters".

It is our great honor to present a 2019-North Branch High School Alumni Association 'Lifetime Achievement Award' to Tom Anderson, Class of 1969.

Lifetime Achievement Award - Karin Schaffner Vukich

KARIN graduated from North Branch High school in May 1984. Again she was not the valedictorian or the salutatorian but was involved in many activities: Soccer, tennis, band, small group ensemble, speech, French club and one-act play. Karin played the mother in a play entitled "Childhood" by Thornton Wilder, a chilling comedy providing a child's view of the grown up world. Karin's class had 144 graduates.

Karin grew up in Almelund which provided her the opportunity to make friends with other people of all ages.

Karin attended Luther College in Decorah, Iowa from 1984 to 1986 and went on to earn an accounting degree from the Minneapolis Business College in 1987. She has worked for Thrivent ever since, currently she is a Business Process Analyst.

In reviewing Karin for the honor of a Lifetime Achievement Award, I read one of her classes Mottos: "In order to live we must seek, in order to seek we must find, in order to find we must experience, in order to experience we must do." Karin took that motto to her heart and soul. Since her father was a pastor in Almelund for 18 years, Karin also indicated that her parents greatly influenced who she has become.

For the past 12 years, Karin has averaged over 600 volunteer hours annually, helping others, locally, nationally and internationally. She volunteers her time at Trinity Lutheran Church in Lindstrom on the council, as chairperson of their endowment committee and most importantly working in youth ministry including mission trip planning and the actual trips!

Karin finds time to work with Meals on Wheels, coordinating 36 volunteers to make actual meal deliveries in the Minneapolis area weekly. In 2013 she was awarded the "Be the Change" Volunteer from Hands on Twin Cities for this outstanding volunteer work.

But she is not finished, not by a long shot. For the past 12 years Karin has been deeply involved both personally and through her employer, Thrivent, with Habitat for Humanity. She has traveled internationally to 13 countries on 'Builds', working on trip coordination, team leadership and actually swinging the hammer! She has traveled nationally to Florida and Mississippi on Habitat for Humanity builds to fix damage from homes lost or damaged by hurricanes. Her influence on others has been and continues to be exceptional.

Karin found the time to be married to husband Louie and raise 3 children, who have also joined her on several 'build' trips.

Personal Tributes:

- Jeannie LeMere, a Thrivent Community Relations Specialist, has worked closely with Karin for 10 plus years, states that "Karin was honored as Employee of the Year in 2011 for her dedication to volunteerism both inside and outside the Thrivent organization."
- Becky Davies, Thrivent Builds Worldwide, states that "Karin has participated in 15 short term service trips around the world since 2006. She has volunteered with local Habitat staff to provide both funds and volunteer labor, helping families improve their living conditions and giving strength to communities in need. Due to her passion and experience, Karin was the obvious choice to lead Thrivent's 1000th team on a build. Karin is a passionate team leader, giving back not only in her own community but communities around the world."
- Linda Rambow, Youth Director at Trinity Lutheran (Lindstrom), acknowledges that "Karin serves on multiple committees at her church and always finds time at the last minute to make the next request work. Karin is very passionate about serving, caring for and making a difference in people's lives. Each time Karin returns from a volunteer trip, you realize the impact that each person and build has had on her as well as those she served. She simply has a passion for life, and making a difference in others' lives."

When asked about her proudest achievement, she referred me to a letter she wrote:

"But the trip that I never forget is my first visit to Poland, where I met Tomas and his two brothers. Tomas was the middle child, age 45 and his two brothers, both physically and mentally disabled, they were wheel chair bound. Tomas took the family savings to build a home but before they could finish, their Mother passed away and the contractor left the house unfinished. The Polish Red Cross stepped in and with the help from Habitat for Humanity and Karins' build team, they were able to finish the house and move Tomas and his brothers into their new home. The two brothers had difficulty communicating even in Polish but they laughed and smiled every day." Karin made lifelong friends and she has many similar stories from her travels.

If you think Karin is worn out from all her activities, think again. She is working on completing her Green Belt training and has run in 43 marathons and plans to complete 60 by age 60!

Did you know? That the first yearbook was published in 1929, 90 years ago and named "The Branch". The Alumni Association has a 1929 copy but we cannot substantiate whether "The Branch" was published in the 30s. We speculate that the depression may have impacted that effort. What we do know is that the newly named "Redite" emerged in 1939 and was published every-other year through the 1940s and 50s. Starting in 1960 it was published each year.

The 2019 Redite has 210 pages and is printed in full color. Those of us of a certain age remember that it persisted in black-and-white during our time. Printing went full color in 2009.



Lillian Johnson Rendahl (class of 1935) sent a substantial extra donation and a note with her alumni registration. The note mentioned that she was looking forward to celebrating her 101st birthday in December. We found her and brought some flowers to celebrate a late birthday in February. Carla Norelius had a wonderful visit with this beautiful lady who not only graduated from NBHS but came back and taught from 1941-44. Lillian taught junior high business and general courses. She recalled Mr. Orwall asking if she would teach Physical Education too. She quickly took a course at the University of Minnesota to allow her to teach PE.

She met her husband Stan while attending Bethel College. In July of 1945 Stan was a chaplain in the army stationed out west and not allowed to take a leave to get married but he was allowed a leave to attend a conference in Duluth. During that time, they were married at her parent's home in Stark. They traveled to see Stan's parents in Sioux Falls following their wedding and 4 days after their marriage he received orders and was sent to the Philippines for 19 months. The couple enjoyed many years of marriage and Stan passed away at age 95.
