## Thank you from your Alumni Association Board

Last year on this cover page we noted the challenges of COVID for the graduating class. Having started in March 2020, COVID was new to all of us and we noted its impact on graduating seniors of the class of 2020. A year and a half later we have experienced a continuation of these challenges and a whole array of unexpected consequences. Amidst all that has been 2020 and 2021, our North Branch Area High School Class of 2021 has endured and graduated into the world as we now know it. This accomplishment underscores the importance of what the mission of the Alumni Association is. Investing in the future of our young people.

This year we wish to highlight two examples that define the essence of our scholarship program. This year Dr. Mike Wilcox (class of `64) generously contributed \$5000 for five \$1000 scholarships for students who intend to pursue careers in medicine and health care. The following is his and his wife Kay's motivation for doing so:

"My name is Mike Wilcox. I am a member of the NBHS Class of 1964. Upon graduation from High School, I continued my



studies at the University of Minnesota, graduating with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Zoology in 1968 followed by a Doctor of Medicine Degree in 1972. As I reflect upon my medical career, I look back fondly upon all of the teachers that I had in high school who assisted me in making the choice of medicine as a career. I am especially grateful for their guidance and encouragement as they assisted me in making this choice. Three, in particular, were especially influential: Mr. Jack Washburn, my biology teacher, Mr. Jack Steeves, my chemistry/physics teacher, and Mr. Chuck Austen, my guidance counselor. These three teachers, during my time at NBHS, continued to support my goal to become a physician. I remain eternally grateful to them, for the support they gave to me, in achieving this dream. Also, their example prompted me, during my time as a physician, to become a part time Professor at the University of Minnesota Medical School and a Health Care Medical Director for EMS Programs for MNSCU. I look forward in providing financial support to future NBHS graduates who wish to go into health care as a career path. Thank

you, teachers, past and present, who have stimulated and continue to stimulate students to choose career paths that are exciting and fulfilling. We remain especially indebted to you". Mike Wilcox, MD

Donations to the Alumni Association are also about remembering those special people in our community who are no longer with us. A vivid example of this emerged this year with the passing of Tom Fisk, a bigger than life figure in the community from the class of 1974. His classmates and friends made possible a \$1000 continuing scholarship for a student who intends to pursue a career in the trades. In the words of Bradley Wilcox ('74):



Tommy was the quintessential North Branch guy. He was loyal to his town and loved the people in it. While his high school counselor questioned his aptitude and potential, he proved himself over and over, whether it was playing in a band, becoming a pilot or building a successful business from the ground up, he excelled and succeeded.

Post high school Tom continued his education at Anoka Tech in the Automotive Tech Program. After a few years working for others he decided to go out on his own and in 1982 he started Fisk Tire. From a humble beginning he continued to build it into a very successful and well run business. But Tom never let the business run him. He always had time for a little (or a lot of) fun with friends and family. (continued on next page)

But probably Tommy's best quality was that he was a true people person with a broad circle of friends. He could have a long conversation with just about anyone and never put on airs of being better than anyone. Family was everything to him. Knowing Tommy made our lives richer, the Class of '74 and Friends would like to keep his legacy alive by helping graduates seek careers in the trades and create their own future".

Several others should be acknowledged as generous, annual contributors to the scholarship program. Among them are Mike and Barb Nelson, Max Malmquist, Beverly Anderson Otterness, the Hamren family and those classes that create scholarships on the year of their reunions.

## LaVerne Magnison-Connor Scholarship for Continuing Education

This \$1000 scholarship is awarded annually to a **former** NBHS graduate who wishes to further their education, going back to school or pursuing a new degree. In other words, this is an opportunity for a person who has been "out in the world" for a few years and has decided to return to school to build on their education.

Background: LaVerne Magnison-Connor (Class of '44) was a NBHS graduate who lived in our community working for the local telephone company in the days when we had live operators in a small telephone office on Main Street. She moved to California in the early 60's but never lost her commitment to our community. She died in Sacramento on August 20, 1998, twenty three years ago. Her estate bequeathed a continuing scholarship to a NBHS graduate who aspires to continued education.

This year's LaVerne Magnison-Connor Scholarship award was given to Matthew Blomquist. Matthew is a 2015 NBHS graduate. He went to Gustavus Adolphus College in St. Peter, Minnesota from 2015-2019. He received a Bachelor of Arts degree in physics with a minor in computer science, had a cumulative GPA of 3.81 (out of 4.0). While he was at Gustavus, he played on the junior varsity basketball team for one year and was a team manager for two others years. He was a Gustavus Student Ambassador for a year, and he volunteered with the local Special Olympics basketball team for two years as a unified partner, among other things.



Matthew enjoyed physics, but he wanted to study something that felt would be a little more impactful to others, so he decided to pursue further education in biomedical engineering. He applied and was accepted into the PhD program at the University of Wisconsin-Madison and he has just started his second year in that program, currently has a 4.0 (out of 4.0) GPA and he has a year to a year and a half more of classes before becoming a dissertator, which is usually around 3 years. This program is, on average, 5 to 5 and a half years long. He has learned a ton so far and is excited to continue learning more!

#### Lifetime Achievement Award Nominations Needed for 2022

#### The 2021 recipient of the Lifetime Achievement award is

#### **Bradley Schaffner – Class of 1977**

Brad Schaffner's North Branch education started from humble origins when, as the 8 year old son of Almelund's Immanuel Lutheran Church's Pastor, Clarence Schaffner, Brad entered Almelund's two-room school midway through the 3<sup>rd</sup> grade. Many in the NB community will tell you that attending the Almelund country school was a treasured experience high in achievement. High school activities in North Branch included the National Honor Society, ski team and the full array of band opportunities playing the cornet. These included playing in the orchestra for the musical "Oklahoma" plus participating in many ensembles that went to regional and state competitions.

After high school graduation in 1977, Brad went on to the following educational pursuits:

#### **Professional Career**

Brad began his professional career at Indiana University Libraries in Bloomington Indiana in 1985 specializing in Slavic Area studies. From 1989-2004 at the University of Kansas, Lawrence Kansas, Brad served as the Russian Studies Librarian, Coordinator of Collection Development, Head of International Programs and Head of the Slavic Department. During this same period, he also served at Emporia State University, Emporia, Kansas as Adjunct Professor, School of Library and Information Management, teaching International Reform Policy. Brad's work during this period at the University of Kansas specializing in Russian and Slavic Studies led to achieving the rank of Librarian III, which is equivalent to a full Professorship. He then went on to Harvard University, Weidener Library, Harvard College Library as Head of Slavic Division from 2004 until 2012. From August 2012 to the present he has been at Carleton College, Northfield, Minnesota as Librarian and Senior Lecturer.






